Our admissions committee looks for capable, enthusiastic students who are academically, socially, and emotionally prepared to handle the challenges of both independent and group learning situations. Our admissions process is very straightforward. We begin with a **phone call** with parents. If it looks like we may be a good fit for your student, we will schedule a time for the **student to meet** with one or two teachers (depending on grade level) and **parents to tour the building/campus** with the Head of School. Please *bring the completed application form and fee to the student meeting and parent tour.* 

In terms of paperwork, the admissions committee will read the student's file when we have received:

- The application form
- Three **teacher recommendations** for grades 1 through 12, two teacher recommendations for Kindergarten. (We provide easy-to-fill-out forms.)
- An **official transcript** from all previous schools attended. (Again, we have provided a form for you to give to your student's schools.)
- Copies of all **standardized test results**
- \$50 application fee
